The Flatlanders will be leaving with some of the other Texas Ski Council groups on the above date to experience one of those “Bucket List” type trips!

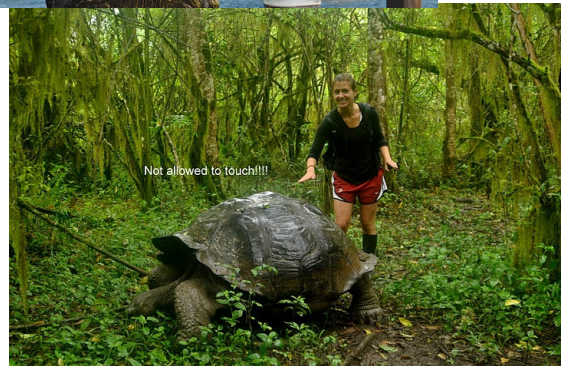
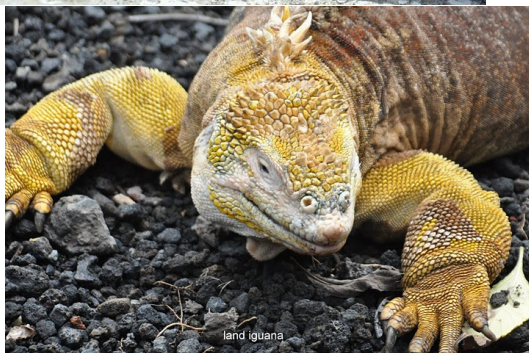
I want to stress that this is a very different trip than most. Because of the location and nature of the park we will be visiting. You will have to commit to the trip and pay your \$700 deposit before Dec. 1. Transportation and park entrance fees need to be paid well in advance of departure. After that date it is highly unlikely you can be added onto the trip.

Total trip price is approximately \$3500 per person. This includes almost all expenses for your 10 day trip except the air from Texas to Ecuador and back. It also includes trip cancellation insurance to protect your investment. That sounds expensive compared to a domestic ski trip. But....this is not a trip to Colorado! This is a part of the world that very few people in Texas will ever see. A protected National Park and Marine Reserve off the coast of South America filled with wildlife some of which is only seen there.
